# **Planned Giving**

In the Annual Rerpot and during our Annual Meeting on January 24<sup>th</sup>, we reflected on the many worship and community service activities carried out at All Saints' during 2015. Significant financial support for these activities came from former members who have departed this earthly life and joined Christ in his heavenly kingdom. \$36,823 supported our budget (10% of the total). \$117,515 was disbursed from unallocated beguests for major repairs and replacements to our building during the year. These include the main and common kitchens, roof repair, phone system upgrade, and new security doors. They accomplished this through Planned Giving by establishing, or adding to, our Church's endowment funds. Some of us recognize the family names of those who made plans to support All Saints' for many years into the future: Royer, Haanes, Widdifield, McIntyre, Furlong, and more. We continue to benefit from beguests that have put in the elevator and handicap access, along with the building addition to accommodate them, major roof repairs, and signage along Pike and Williams Streets.

The impact these former members have made through their bequests of all sizes, large and small, has been profound. We thank God for their planned giving to carry on the mission and ministry of All Saints'.
